Two earthenware beard dishes - Moustiers and Eastern France - 19th century Set consisting of two earthenware beard dishes, of typical scalloped shapes, intended for shaving use. The first, of good size, features polychrome decoration in the taste of Moustiers, with an elegant central bird surrounded by floral scrolls and small insects. The wing is underlined by a green fillet. The second, more sober, offers a stylized floral decoration with ochre garland and foliage, evoking a production from eastern France. The reverses show old traces of use, with hanging system and handwritten inscriptions, including a later inscription "Dvx Moustiers Fait main".
