Description

This office wastebasket is a characteristic example of luxury leather covering (gainerie) from the second half of the 20th century. The structural design relies on a rigid cylindrical core entirely sheathed in smooth leather. The assembly demonstrates great technical mastery: the bright orange leather piece is firmly joined by a vertical seam and a top band highlighted by dark "saddle" stitching. The edges of the leather feature a smooth black burnished finish (astiquage), contrasting with the orange exterior and matching the dark lining of the inner vat. The use of this specific shade of orange, inseparable from the world of French luxury, combined with the rigor of the saddle stitching, places this piece in the strict aesthetic lineage of Maison Hermès productions or Jacques Adnet's office accessories.

Condition report: Good overall condition. The leather displays a slight natural patina of use with minimal superficial rubbing inherent to its function, without altering the structure. The stitching is firm and continuous. This timeless office accessory will bring a bold touch of color and undeniable standing to a workspace, whether classic, modernist, or contemporary in style.
