He painted mainly landscapes and portraits in oil and pastel (Musée des Beaux arts de Nantes, Musée Rolin d'Autun, Musée d'Annonay in the Ardèche and Musée des Beaux Arts de Nîmes (portrait of the sculptor Vidal)). An inscription on the back indicates that this is a "painting by Joseph Coront Ducluzeau in 1902" and that it is "Marie Joséphine Jeanne Angèle Coront Ducluzeau Rey". "Born in 1884", Marie
