Jan Martsen de Jonge Dutch painter Haarlem circa 1609 - Amsterdam after 1647 Portrait of a young horseman performing the levade Oil on panel: 32.9 x 28.6 cm Signed and dated lower center "JM D Jonge 1634" Frame: 47.1 x 43.3 cm Jan Martsen de Jonge was one of the important witnesses of the succesfull last decades of the Eighty Years' War, when Stadtholder Prince Frederick Henry led the Dutch to independence from Spain. Two contemporary Amsterdam painters specialised in such small portraits, mainly of Stadtholders, on horseback: Pauwels van Hillegaert and Hendrick Ambrosius Pax.
