Description

Hunting scene, watercolor etching on paper signed Cecil Aldin (1870-1935), an English painter renowned for his equestrian and hunting depictions. The highly dynamic composition illustrates a pack of hounds launched at full speed in the foreground, pursuing game across an open landscape. In the background, red-clad riders follow the hunt through gently rolling countryside, punctuated by hedges and bare trees, evoking an autumn or winter scene. The treatment is fine and precise, particularly in the rendering of moving dogs and horses, a signature of Aldin's talent. The sober, luminous palette reinforces the realistic, elegant atmosphere of this scene typical of the English tradition of hunting with hounds. Work presented in a wooden frame with passe-partout.
