Buffet Bibliothèque deux corps in rosewood, Napoleon III period, 19th century. It consists of a lower part opening with two solid doors, framed by twisted columns resting on massive feet. The belt is embellished with worked moldings and a central drawer adorned with a bronze keyhole. The upper part features a glazed body with two doors, with molded frames with scalloped decoration, revealing an interior shelf. The antique fittings, handles and keyways contribute to the charm of the ensemble. Beautiful warm rosewood patina, with rich decoration typical of Renaissance-inspired historicist production of the 19th century.
