Description

A richly carved oak cabinet of Gothic inspiration, dating from the 19th century. The facade features a particularly elaborate decoration with a central panel adorned with a heraldic motif framed by arcatures and colonnettes. The jambs are decorated with twisted motifs and stylized plant carvings. An openwork frieze with quatrefoils enlivens the middle section, reinforcing the neo-Gothic aesthetic of the whole. The lower section opens through a door revealing a shelved interior offering a fine storage capacity. The piece of furniture rests on short, massive legs, giving it stability and presence. Very beautiful dark patina of the oak, highlighting the depth of the carvings and the antique character of the furniture.
