Important decorative Bohemian crystal pipe from the late 19th century, made from blown, molded and finely cut crystal. This large-scale piece (46 cm) bears witness to remarkable glassmaking skills: the body is animated by bulges, moldings and cuts that catch the light with elegance, illustrating the quality of Bohemian production of this period. The stove, in the shape of a fluted cup, is part of a composition entirely dedicated to aesthetics. This type of object, more decorative than functional, was intended to adorn interiors and demonstrate the technical virtuosity of Bohemian workshops. The object is assembled in two parts.
