Description

Presented here is a fine example of a late 19th-century seascape, executed in oil on a metal panel in the traditions of the European marine school. At the centre of the dynamic composition is a small sailboat battling the stormy waves. A little further away in the haze, steep cliffs and a small merchant sailing vessel can be seen. Both vessels are attempting to leave the harbour and reach the open sea to avoid being smashed against the shore by the storm. The scene is built on a harmonious contrast: the deep blue-green tones of the turbulent sea are juxtaposed with the light areas of the cloudy sky and the warm hues of the rocky coast. Vivid brushstrokes of foam on the crests of the waves make the composition more expressive, filling it with the dramatic atmosphere of the raging sea. This impressive
