Description

Joseph CROZES, painter born in Arvieu (Aveyron), active from the 1930s to 1950. Although he mainly painted landscapes, he also devoted himself to still lifes. In Paris, he exhibited at the Salon des Artistes Français in 1933, at the Salon des Indépendants from 1938 and at the Salon d'Automne in 1941. His style is very often akin to Post-Impressionism, as in this superb painting, an oil on canvas from the 1930s/1950s depicting a view of Douarnenez from Tréboul (Finistère). Work signed lower right, countersigned and titled on the back. Presence of a label from a Charente-Maritime artists' union indicating the Salon des Indépendants as the origin of the work.
