Large silver kettledrum, almost straight form, with flat bottom and flared rim outlined with fillets. The body is decorated at the top with a wide frieze of engraved floral scrolls. France, Paris, circa 1809-1819. Silver 950/1000, Coq hallmark. Master silversmith: Louis Tassin, Paris, 1803-1814, specialized in the manufacture of cups and timbales. Teodor Tonnelier took over his workshop. Height: 9.7 cm Diameter at neck: 8.7 cm Diameter at bottom: 6.9 cm Weight: 130 g Capacity: 350 ml Good condition, with no repairs or repolishing; small dents to report.
