Large free-form dish in glazed ceramic by Jean Lurçat for the Sant Vicens pottery, decorated with 2 fantastic characters and foliage on a black and white background, numbered 15/50. Circa 1960. Perfect condition. Dimensions 47 x 52 cm. Signed on reverse J. Lurçat Sant Vicens 15/50. Lurçat Jean (1892-1966) The master of contemporary tapestry turned to ceramics in the early 50s. He regularly visited the Sant-Vicens pottery workshop, created by Firmin Bauby at Perpignan. There, he decorated dishes, vases, jugs and other everyday objects. His work as a ceramist is also marked by monumental creations, such as the one that adorns the Maison de la Radio in Strasbourg.
