Rare type of sickle blade known as "lion's claw" (makhles s'ba). According to Charles Buttin (cf catalog of the Charles Buttin collection of Buttin's collection of antique European and Oriental weapons); this type of blade was reserved for the sultans' black guard.  
Beautiful blond horn handle. Silver scabbard chased with arabesques and floral motifs. Some small dents to the silver. Length 35cm
