The whole is enriched with boxwood fillet inlays, visible notably on the top rail, adding an extra touch of refinement. The belt conceals a functional drawer, practical and discreet, ideal for everyday use. The front corners are highlighted by bronze baguettes, while the legs end in decorative falls also in bronze, reinforcing the elegance of the silhouette. Made from native wood, this piece seduces with the warmth of its patina and the quality of its cabinetwork. The whole is perfectly stable and presents a beautiful aesthetic
