This denuded young Egyptian, perfectly illustrates the orientalist taste developed at the end of the 19th century. The subtly sculpted model is a perfect example of the orientalist taste developed at the end of the 19th century. The subtle modelling of the face, as well as the delicate treatment of the fabrics, testify to the skill of Bastet, a sculptor renowned for his decorative compositions imbued with elegance and exoticism. The work is signed "Bastet" on the terrace and bears the circular stamp of the Manufacture de Sèvres, as well as an edition number.
