Description

Very beautiful Art Deco platinum and 18-carat gold ring, rectangular in shape, set with diamonds including two larger center stones. The two main diamonds, half-sizes of approximately 0.60 carat each, catch the light with great brilliance.

According to our assessment: one diamond has VS clarity and I color; the other has P clarity and H color, with faint fluorescence. They are surrounded by millegrain-set diamonds, typical of 1930s designs. The geometric lines give this ring all the architectural elegance typical of the Art Deco style. French work, circa 1930. Dog head and eagle punches. Very good overall condition. Finger size: 52.5. A discreet bridge on the band has been added to ensure a better fit on the finger and to prevent the ring from

turning. Weight: 6.20 g
