Fine miniature portrait on ivory of a Lieutenant de Chasseurs à Pieds, wearing the Légion d'Honneur. The dark blue uniform, daffodil collar, white vest, white epaulets and silver buttons are clearly visible. The miniature is presented in a carved blackened wood frame with a chased and gilded bronze window. Empire period, circa 1805-1810. Dressed in his uniform, the man is elegant and well-represented, with a handsome face and expressive blue eyes. Work in ivory, painted more than 120 years before the 1947 Washington Convention and therefore in accordance with the regulations governing the ivory trade. Our miniature is in excellent condition.
