Napoleon III period pedestal table, resting on an elegant tripod base in finely carved walnut. The molded belt is highlighted by a carved frieze at the bottom. The turned central shaft rests on three curved feet ending in scrolls, bringing balance and elegance to the whole. This small accent piece, both decorative and functional, will find a perfect place in a classic interior or as a contrast in a contemporary setting. Era: Napoleon III, circa 1850-1880.
