Its richly carved belt, sturdy turned legs and deep patina bear witness to centuries of use, care and tradition. Oak has acquired a warm, expressive surface, full of character and historical richness. What really sets this table apart is its exceptional extension system. Rare for its time, it can be extended to an extraordinary length of 470 cm, offering a dimension rarely encountered in antique furniture. This impressive extension transforms the table from an intimate family table into a grand space capable of hosting large receptions, celebrations or long, refined dinners. The mechanism is beautifully integrated, preserving the table's authenticity while offering
