Description

A fine polychrome terracotta statuette depicting a seated beggar, created during the 18th century and signed "C.P." The work is striking for the extraordinary expressiveness of the face and the naturalistic rendering of the posture, elements that recall the 18th-century folk and devotional sculptural tradition typical of Italian Nativity art. The figure is depicted in a moment of intense humanity: his gaze turned upward and his outstretched hand evoke a scene of powerful emotional realism, while his tattered clothes and traveler's staff are modeled with remarkable attention to detail. The original polychromy, with pleasant signs of aging and wear consistent with the period, lends further charm and authenticity to the piece.
