White porcelain footed bowl, richly decorated in fine gold in an Empire spirit. The decoration, of great elegance, features a laurel wreath framing a bee, the imperial symbol par excellence, repeated in a frieze with stars around the rim. The interior repeats this same decorative vocabulary, creating a very harmonious whole. The well-balanced form rests on a pedestal also adorned with laurel friezes and highlighted with wide gilded fillets. The quality of the gilding, still quite bright, underlines the decorative and refined character of the piece. Nineteenth-century work in the taste of prestige productions inspired by the First Empire, close to the models made for the great houses of Paris or Limoges.
