These vases feature a finely etched, acid-cleared decoration depicting a lakeside landscape alive with aquatic flowers, treated in shades of blue and green against an opalescent background. The neck, in shaded pale green tones, is topped by a contrasting dark lip. The glasswork, with superimposed colored layers and openwork decoration, is fully in keeping with the Art Nouveau aesthetic, evoking French glassware productions of the Gallé or Daum type, with no visible signature.
