Each vase presents a poetic scene composed of trees with delicate branches, a body of water with a boat and figures, and mountainous reliefs in the background. The decoration, treated in black silhouette and brown-green shades, stands out against a gradated background ranging from orange to pale yellow, evoking a sunset light. The slightly grainy glass work is characteristic of the productions of the École de Nancy of the early 20th century, in the spirit of the creations of Daum or Gallé.
