Description

Table lamp in pate de verre , adorned with a rich acid-etched plant decoration. The globular base and dome-shaped shade are made from luminous yellow-green glass, covered with several finely worked layers. The decoration depicts dense foliage embellished with stylized flowers, treated in relief in olive-green and brown tones, with delicate white flowers providing a refined contrast. The acid etching work, combined with the superimposition of glass layers, is characteristic of early 20th-century École de Nancy productions, evoking the works of Émile Gallé or Daum. Original gilded metal frame holding the lampshade, contributing to the elegance of the whole. Very beautiful decorative object, both luminous and sculptural. Dimensions: Height: 48 cm Era: Second
