Edmond DELPHAUT (1891-1957) was a painter and sculptor, artist (painter and sculptor) who created several sculptures of soldiers of the Great War, commissioned by French and German communities. In particular, he created a memorial to Serbian prisoners at Königsbrück in Germany, one of his major works. He took part in the Great War of 1914-1918, where he was taken prisoner and detained in the Königsbrück camp, where he painted portraits of prisoners of various nationalities, including Serbs.
