Large pair of Art Deco vases signed Leune - François-Émile Leune, famous for his creations with naturalistic and exotic decorations characteristic of the 1920s-1930s. These polychrome Enamelled glass vases feature a remarkable decoration of stylized birds perched on branches, surrounded by lush foliage treated in deep shades of greens, blues and ochres. The dynamic composition, rich enamels and fine design bear full witness to the French Art Deco aesthetic

This spectacular "Kingfisher" decoration perfectly illustrates the aesthetic revival of Maison Leune in the 1920s, spurred on by the talented Auguste Heiligenstein, the house's artistic director between 1923 and 1926. Inspired by the rise of Art Deco, this model features

The lightly granulated background particularly highlights the vivid colors and black outline work typical of the decorative productions of this period.
