Silver whisky/alcohol flask, slightly curved shape with smooth body. It features its tumbler as well as a chain clip with screw attachment. The lid has a sealing device with a resin gasket secured by a screw, as well as a hinge. It opens by turning the top 90 degrees counter-clockwise. Art Deco style. French work circa 1900. Minerve hallmark 950/1000. Master goldsmith: Henin & Cie, marked on the bottom of the tumbler by a monogram: Mellerio dit Meller. Dimensions: Height with lid: 15 cm Width: 8.5 cm Thickness: 1.8 cm Weight: 316 g Capacity: 160 ml Very good condition; a small dent on the bottom of the tumbler is to be noted.
