Description

This coastal scene, depicting the cliffs and rocks of Étretat in Normandy, was painted in the first half of the 19th century by a representative of the French School. The world-famous Étretat cliffs are chalk cliffs up to 100 meters high, located on Normandy's Côte d'Albâtre. They are renowned for their spectacular rock arches (Aval, Amont, Manneporte) and needles. Inscription: vestige of signature lower right. Technique: oil on wood panel, period gilded frame. Dimensions: unframed: 27.5 x 21.5 cm; framed: 44.5 x 38.5 cm. Condition: good.
