Box in marquetry of wood, mother-of-pearl, bone, and pewter Napoleon III period The interior is in perfect condition, lined with burgundy velvet. Inlaid by Franz Xaver Fortner, the renowned Bavarian cabinetmaker. He founded his workshop in Munich in 1826 and became one of the most important cabinetmakers of his time. He exported his work to England, Russia, and France, and worked for several noble families. Franz Xaver Fortner (1798-1877) was one of the most celebrated cabinetmakers of his time in southern Germany. In 1826, he founded his company in Munich and worked primarily for the nobility. By 1842, he employed 30 craftsmen. His specialties were furniture with rich inlays. Some of Franz Xaver Fortner's furniture is in the Munich City Museum and the Bavarian National
