large model in wood, various materials and metals, of the 1st rank (104 guns) three-masted ship of the line (37 sails) armed in 1778 and crewed by over 800 members (821 at the Battle of Trafalgar). She was equipped with . 30 32-pounder guns (lower deck), . 28 24-pounder guns (middle deck), . 30 12-pounder guns (upper deck), . 12 12-pounder cannons (quarter deck), . 2 x 68-pound carronades and 2 x 12-pound carronades (forecastle). Home port: Portsmouth Launched in 1765 and now preserved in dry dock, she is the oldest intact warship in the world. This warship boasts a large number of victories between 1778 and 1812. Configured under various commands, she is best known as the vessel of Admiral Horatio Nelson, courageous and a fine tactician, at the Battle of Trafalgar
