Small oval bowl from fine openwork ceramic, reminiscent of lace. It rests on a small foot and features a basket-weave-style decoration, rich in color and enhanced by gilding, organized around four medallions. The piece bears a beautiful signature under base, dated to the period 1878-1898, manufacture founded in 1853 by Vilmos Zsolnay in Pécs (Hungary), a company of international renown awarded a gold medal in Paris in 1878. The trademark reads as follows: "Zsolnay - Pécs", the "city of five steeples", accompanied by the initials T.J.M., corresponding to the first names of Vilmos Zsolnay's children, associated the company.
