Description

This work is part of the informal art or lyrical abstraction, and the technique of tachism, in which the artist uses juxtaposed or superimposed touches of color to create an emotion or a visual rhythm, with impasto giving relief and life to the canvas. The choice of colors mixing touches of red with a dominance of umber and bright yellow and bright yellow is typical of the late 70s, with the addition of dark masses creating a beautiful contrast. The whole gives this work character to this work. The style is similar to that of major figures artists such as Jean-Paul Riopelle, André Lansky and Roger Bissière.
