Size unframed 23x 32 framed 38.5 x 47 Fernand Le Gout-Gérard (1854-1924) A student at the Collège Collège de Saint-Lô, he became a tax collector, following in his father's footsteps, of the Trésorerie Générale de la Manche. But at the age of 33, he decided to give up his profession for painting. He discovered Concarneau around 1890 and returned there for over forty years. A member of the Société nationale des Beaux-Arts and the Pastel Society of London, he was appointed painter to the Navy in 1900. He settled permanently in Concarneau in 1903, and his home, the famous villa Ty Ker Moor, became a meeting place for Concarneau painters. He painted markets, fairs and fishing trips. A painter of
