Tea box, natsume, for tea ceremony macha tea. In black lacquered wood with susuki herb decorations in gold and silver makie lacquer with silver dew pearls. The bottom is beautifully worked revealing the wood veins. For the tea ceremony, the tea master chooses his objects according to the seasons, guests, events... The susuki plant is one of the 7 emblematic plants of autumn landscapes in Japan, and is an essential decoration during the mid-autumn moon festival. Historically, it was mainly used to thatch roofs or feed livestock. The Japanese appreciate its simplicity and elegance. Artist : Yoshida Shoun (b. 1940) Japan, 7.5 x 7.5 cm.
