Beautifully carved scrolls around the edge, high-relief connecting dice, fluted tapered legs, curved spacer with a row of piastres adorned with a high-relief rosette in the center. Beautifully proportioned sculpture, particularly the spacer. This console has the great advantage of being on 4 legs, which means it doesn't have to be fixed to the wall like a bracket. It looks large, but its shallow depth means it takes up very little space. It is ideal for use as a hall console or as a sideboard in a dining room. Charming 18th-century object, ideal for a country home. Very good overall condition, structurally sound and in good condition, minor restorations (old reinforcement under the
