Rare plaster cast of "Femme dite Femme à l'aryballe" Neo-Sumerian. She is seated on a cubic seat, her long hair is held back by a headband and she is wearing a striped ruffled dress. The patina reproduces the material of the alabaster. Excellent condition. Stamped Musée du Louvre. Late 19th/early 20th century. Today this molding is no longer made of plaster but of resin.... The original was discovered in Babylonia (2350-2200 BC) in alabaster and is preserved in the Musée du Louvre. The dimensions of the cast are identical to the original: Ht: 20cm, Larg: 8cm, Prof: 10cm, Weight: 735,5g. EXTRA EXPEDITION. All our objects carry with them the traces of their history.
