Description

A crucified Christ in ivory represented on a cross with a triangular base adorned with mother-of-pearl mother-of-pearl elements with engraved and tinted details, combined with darker wood to form simple floral, vegetal and geometric motifs. The front features the INRI symbol. A reliquary lodge is located at the base, marked Boniface (13th-century Pope). The shape of this Latin cross and decoration are reminiscent of examples created in the Holy Land in the 18th and 19th centuries as souvenirs for pilgrims. Slightly missing.
