A very well silvered water pot, richly decorated and chased with 18th century nobility motifs and decorations:-Lily flowers (4) at the top surrounding the frétel.-Family coat of arms on a top face with laurel surround and succeeds it at the bottom:..A radiant floral bouquet supported by a garland with hanging ends.On another face:..Maltese cross surrounded by laurel branches succeeding it in the lower part:..A radiant floral bouquet.On the front flank:.. A fleur-de-lys succeeds it at the bottom:..A viscount's crown..A Maltese cross surrounded by laurels is placed on another side,..A broad, radiant floral bouquet, in a solar fashion, dominates a hanging garland,..A bright Sun King finishes off the bottom of the pot's grip handle..Simple flowers are scattered throughout the spaces ,..A motif of wide ovals
