### Description

A large bronze with a brown patina shaded with green, depicting a young shepherd seated on a rock, holding a staff and accompanied by a sheep at his feet. The composition features a naturalistic treatment of great finesse, both in the anatomical modeling and in the work on the drapery and rocky base. The work is signed Paul Gasq and bears the stamp of the foundryman Ferdinand Barbedienne, Paris. This is a very fine antique cast preserved in its original patina, which has been fully cleaned and waxed by a professional bronzier. Paul Gasq (1860-1944), Prix de Rome in 1890, belonged to the generation of French academic sculptors of the late 19th century. His work combines elegance of design and a sense of realism in a vein inspired by pastoral and allegorical subjects. Height: 78 cm Original
