### Description

Exceptional and monumental Art Nouveau bronze vase, richly sculpted with two elegant peacock embracing the body of the vase in a fluid, organic composition. With an impressive height of 110 cm, this remarkable work perfectly embodies the refined naturalism and decorative exuberance characteristic of the French Art Nouveau in the late 19th and early 20th centuries. The vase is adorned with a sumptuous decoration of finely chased feathers covering its surface, while the long, graceful necks of the peacocks wrap around the neck of the vase, creating a remarkable effect of movement and harmony. The meticulous treatment of the plumage, egrets, claws and long outstretched tails testifies to a level of artistic mastery and craftsmanship. Created in bronze.

with a brown patina and delicate gold highlights, this sculpture reveals a subtle interplay of textures and light. The elegant silhouette and sensual lines immediately evoke the prestigious creations presented at the 1900 Paris World's Fair, where the peacock became one of the emblematic motifs of Art Nouveau, symbolizing beauty, luxury and exoticism. This highly decorative, museum-quality piece was most probably created in the spirit of - or even on the occasion of - the 1900 Exposition Universelle, during which the most remarkable bronzes and objets d'art inspired by the and objets d'art inspired by the peacock theme were produced by the great French artists and workshops.
