Rouen earthenware dish, dating from the XVIIIe century. This model features a delicate central decoration depicting a carnation, treated in blue cameo on a tin glaze background. This floral motif, both simple and elegant, is fully in keeping with the decorative repertoire of Rouen workshops of this period. This model features a delicate central decoration featuring a carnation, treated in blue monochrome on a stanniferous enamel ground. The soberly ornamented wing highlights the central subject and demonstrates a decorative balance characteristic of XVIIIe century production. Rouen earthenware, developed notably under the impetus of figures such as Edme Poterat, experienced a major boom
