Pair of Chinese polychrome porcelain pots mounted in bronze - 18th century period. Beautiful pair of baluster-shaped Chinese pots in enameled porcelain with rich floral and vegetal decoration on a yellow ground, embellished with circular turquoise-blue circular reserves. The highly refined decoration evokes 18th-century Qing dynasty production. The 18th century, in the spirit of Famille Rose porcelain, intended both for the Chinese market and for European export. The pots rest on elegant, finely chased gilded bronze mounts: base and collar, giving the ensemble a precious, decorative presentation typical of 18th and 19th century interior design. The reverse features the old traces and inscriptions of inventory or

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collection visible under the mount, testifying to the age and provenance of these pieces. Very fine decorative quality with luminous enamels and a particularly elegant harmony of colors.
