Description

Pair of large bisque busts after *Jean-Antoine Houdon representing the Brongniart children. Louise and Alexandre are the two children of the architect Alexandre-Théodore Brongniart, famous for the construction of the Paris Bourse (Palais Brongniart).both busts are signed **Tharaud in Limoges. They end with shower feet in blue porcelain with gold fillet (slightly different).
Limoges early XX th *Jean-Antoine Houdon, born March 20, 1741[1] in Versailles and died July 15, 1828 in Paris, was a French sculptor.
**Camille Tharaud, born in Limoges on April 20, 1878 and died on September 8, 1956[1], was a French ceramist.
