An elegant production from the late Louis XVI period (18th century, circa 1780-90), our trumeau is decorated with a trophy with ribbons and laurel leaves. The mirror is framed in carved and gilded wood with a heart and pearl motif. Original gold leaf gilding, 2-piece sparkling mercury mirror, also 18th century. A highly decorative and spectacular piece; it is tall but narrow, which presents multi-purpose: it can be placed on a mantelpiece, on a piece of furniture between two windows.
