This pipe head bears witness to a very high level of craftsmanship and exceptional carving quality, enhanced by a beautiful warm brown patina beautifully highlighting the details of the decoration. The reverse features a rich floral decoration carved around the hearth. Beautiful authentic condition with a few small cracks and chips due to age and material, but no breaks. Rare collector's item, decorative and of high quality.
