Description

Baoyueping blue-white porcelain gourd vase - China (19th century) A flattened gourd-shaped vase called Baoyueping or moon gourd in porcelain with blue-white decoration. This model, inspired by Near Eastern pilgrim gourds, became an emblem of refinement under the Ming and Qing dynasties. The circular body features a central medallion on each side animated by the theme of the "Hundred Antiques". It features flowering vases on saddles, incense burners, auspicious symbols and fruit baskets for longevity. The rim and neck are decorated with lotus scrolls and foliage. The two handles are dragon-shaped. China - late Qing dynasty, 19th century. Please note an old chip on the upper rim of the neck. Visible at Galerie Courcelles Antiquités, 97 rue de Courcelles, in the 17th
