In Japanese culture, the rooster is a symbol of courage, punctuality and strength, and combined with flowers, it creates a decorative and auspicious image. The back of the vase depicts a Japanese landscape, with a village, river and mountains. Intricate geometric and plant motifs fill the empty spaces. Kutani, Japan, Meiji era (1868-1912). Mark ???
