The painting depicts the massif through a dense, textured application of paint and a controlled use of ochre and brown tones. composition is occupied by a rocky plateau rendered in ochre and brown tones, with modeling achieved through overlapping brushstrokes. The peaks rise upward and are rendered in a range of browns and yellows, while the uniform, clear sky frames the vertical structure of the mountain range. The artist's signature and date appear in the lower right corner. Available with a 7 cm antique fir wood frame, custom-made in our restoration workshop.
