Description

19th-century oil painting depicts the Staubbach Falls in the Lauterbrunnen Valley of the Bernese Oberland, Switzerland. The artwork is characterized by a central vertical composition showing a single, narrow waterfall cascading from a high, light-colored limestone cliff on the right side. The scene is set in a deep mountain valley, with a broad dirt path or roadway in the lower center foreground.
