The backgrounds, in delicate shades of cobalt blue, powder pink, raspberry and ivory, give the ensemble a fresh decorativeness and refinement typical of Haviland's luxury production for the bourgeois and American clientele of the early twentieth century. The saucers are available in a variety of colors, including blue, pink, pink, raspberry and ivory.
